The Catahoula Hotel is a 35-room boutique hotel in downtown New Orleans. Originally built in 1845, the hotel resides in a restored creole townhouse nestled on a quiet side street in the Central Business District.

This historic property was once a home and that is what drives our ethos – to welcome guests as we would someone into our own home, to care for them and do whatever it takes to ensure their time with us is as memorable as possible.

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# rooftop terrace

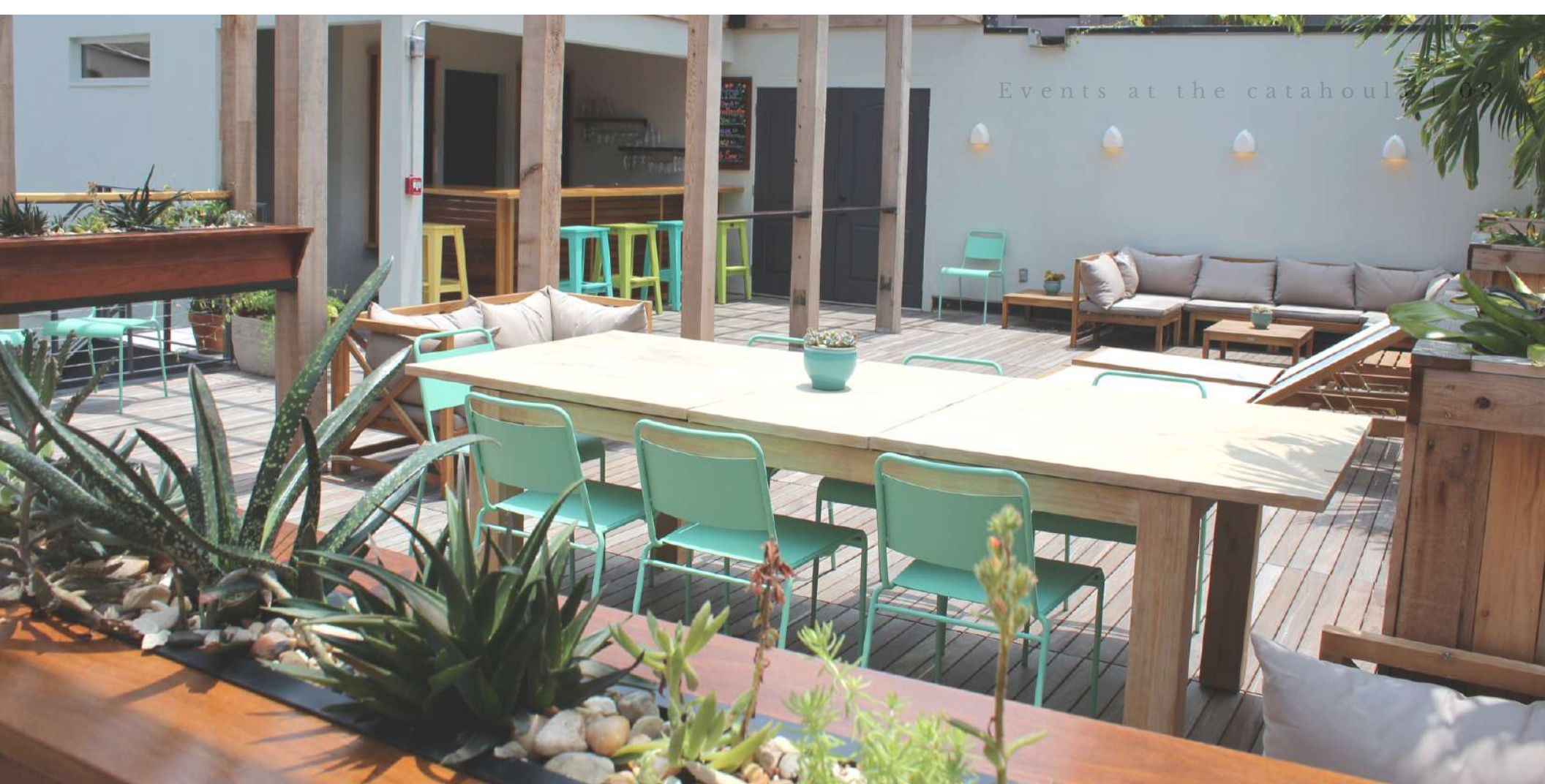
The Rooftop Terrace is located on the third story of our three-story restored Creole Townhouse. The Terrace features an Ipe wooden deck, wooden pergola, lounge furniture, large palms and upward skyline views of New Orleans. The Terrace also has a full service cocktail bar.

The space is ideal for a lively cocktail party. It can hold a maximum of 75 people and can be used for a maximum of 4 hours with events ending by 10 pm.

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## cafe & courtyard

The Café & Courtyard are located on the first story of our three-story restored Creole Townhouse. The Café & Courtyard are two separate spaces but are reserved together. The Café connects to the lobby and featured black and white checkered tile floors, Venetian plaster and exposed brick walls, and artwork by well-known local artists. A piano is available as well.

The Courtyard is connected to the Café and features the same black and white tile, a towering installation artwork by local artist Walker Babington, and ferns and foliage throughout.

The spaces together are ideal for a lively cocktail party or a medium sized seated dinner. Because of the nature of the hotel, these spaces must be bought out in tandem or used to host a non-private event. The hotel does not provide in-house catering but rather supports an array of local vendors. Details for preferred caterers are available upon request.

# fine print

- There is a \$100 service fee per bartender and per server for the event. The number of staff members needed for the event is determined by hotel management.
- All food and beverage prices and room rental fees are subject to 10.75% state sales tax and 24% taxable service charge.
- Events require a minimum Food and Beverage purchase of \$1,500, unless it is a buyout of the Café and Courtyard requiring us to close the space to the public, in which case the minimum is \$3,000. If the minimum is not met, the remaining balance will be charged as a room rental fee. This minimum purchase does not include staff fees, service charges or taxes.
- Events at the Hotel can last a maximum of 4 hours.
- All events at the Hotel must end by 10pm.
- There will be a 15-minute grace period after the event stop time. If the event goes over the 15- minute grace period the server fees (service fee for each bartender and service) will be doubled for the event.
- Up to a 3-piece band is allowed to perform in the spaces until 10 pm. The band must set up in specified areas decided by the Hotel Management. The volume limit is determined at the discretion of the hotel manager on duty during the function.
- No confetti or candles may be brought into the space. All decorations must be approved by hotel management.
- Outside catering is permitted for an additional \$100 fee. Details on preferred vendors available upon request.
- There will be a minimum \$500 clean up fee for an excessive mess or damage to the space. The fee is non-refundable, non-negotiable and at the discretion of hotel management.
- Furniture that is moved from its original place must be returned to its original condition at the end of the event. Failure to do so will result in a \$200 labor fee. The fee is non-refundable, non-negotiable and at the discretion of hotel management.
